

REDHILL ARCHERS BEGINNERS COURSE

Participants are accepted subject to the following rules and guidelines.*

1. Completion of the Beginners Course Application form.
2. Payment of the appropriate fee in advance.
3. Weather, equipment and the availability of Club members may disrupt the proposed programme of sessions. Alternative dates will be offered for any sessions lost.
4. A register for each session will be maintained recording all participants and all supervising Club members.
5. Participants will enter the Club hut only by invitation and only if accompanied by a Senior club member.
6. Shooting will be under the strict control of a nominated senior member of the Club, the Field Captain. If there are participants between the ages of 16 and 18 who are not accompanied by a parent the Field Captain will not be directly involved in giving instruction.
7. Participants will shoot under the close supervision of a Senior Club member.
8. Participants will approach the Shooting Line only when instructed by a Club member and will leave the line when they have completed shooting.
9. There may occasions when the instructing archer wishes to make bodily contact in order to teach. This will always be preceded by a request to the archer.

Junior Participants

1. Must be at least 8 years old.
2. 8 to 15 year olds must be supervised at all times by a parent.
3. 16 to 18 year olds need not be accompanied by a parent but a parent must attend the start of the first session in order to submit the Application Form

Photography
